Sense of Place & Wellbeing in Wetlands: Using Film & the Arts to achieve SDG3

Join us to discover and discuss WetlandLIFE, a major UK research project funded by the Valuing Nature Programme. The session will cover:

- Integrating arts, film and social sciences, alongside ecological and economic approaches, to value wetlands from multiple perspectives;
- Understanding and communicating wellbeing in wetlands, including sense of place and 3-dimensional social wellbeing;
- Using interdisciplinary approaches to address real or perceived risks associated with wetlands, such as mosquitoes.

The session will include talks by experts in cultural valuation and our WetlandLIFE artists and social scientists, followed by a discussion around the practicalities and opportunities of integrated approaches to wetland research and management.
